



### Circular

This is to notify all the schools having Primary classes that as per the 18<sup>th</sup> National Education Conference, 2017, to strengthen literacy and numeracy at the lower primary levels, some topics and concepts from Environmental Studies (EVS) have been infused into English curricula for classes PP to III. Accordingly, the English Section of REC has reviewed and revised the curricula along with some changes in the implementation strategies.

The revised curricula for classes PP and I was completed and currently being implemented since 2018 academic session. Similarly, as a part of the revision, new teaching learning activities for classes II and III have been developed to be included in the Teacher Guides. As an interim measure, we are sending the provisional edition of the guide in soft copies for immediate implementation. The changes will be incorporated in the Teacher Guides in 2020 reprint version. These revised curricula include many new activities wherein Place Based Education (PBE) principles have been incorporated as a strategy and approach to make language learning more engaging and meaningful.

Therefore, all the schools having primary classes are required to note the changes and implement the revised curricula accordingly.
