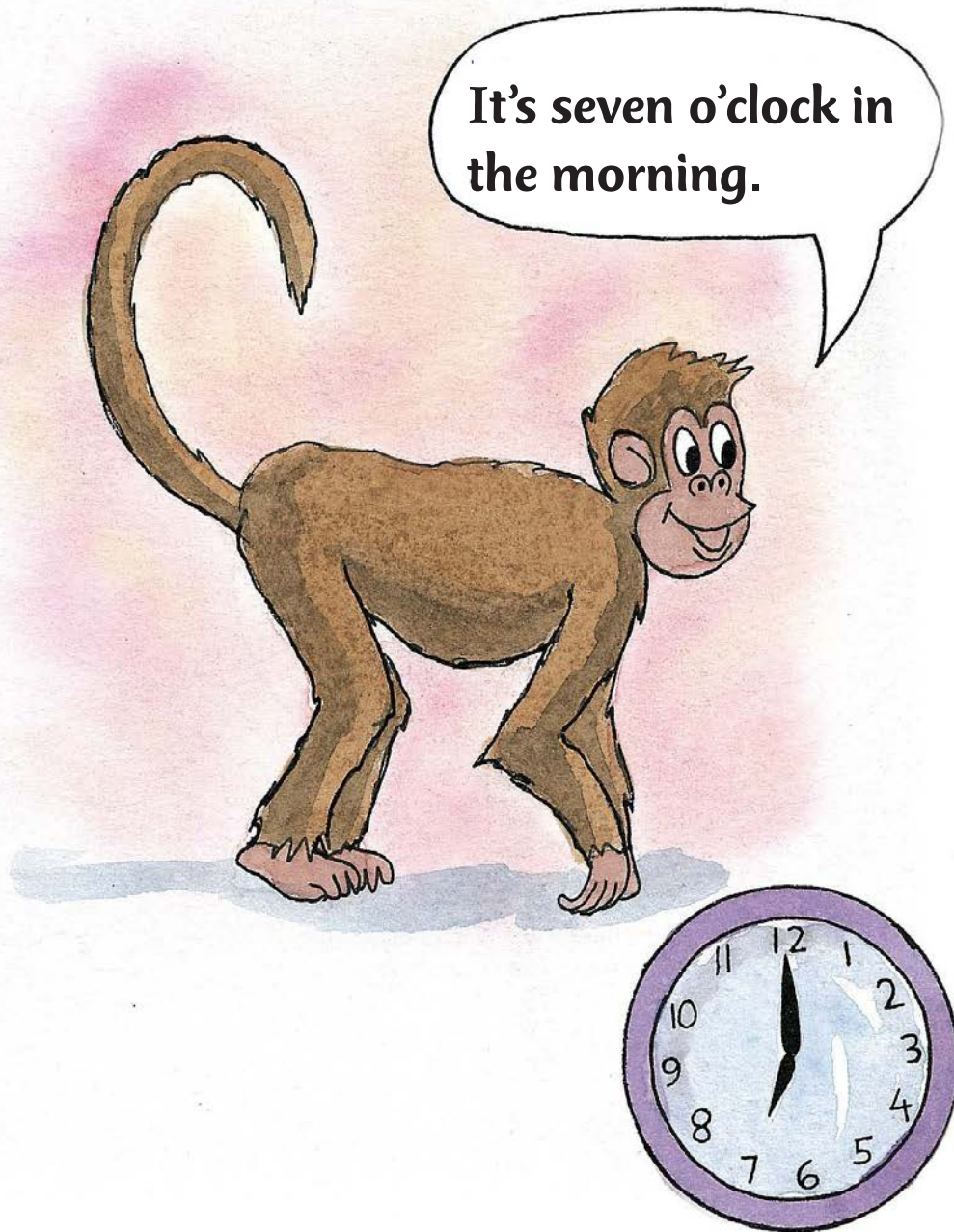
It's six o'clock in the morning.
