



This is a takin. It is big and looks like a cow. It is found only in Bhutan. It is our national animal.




They eat grass. We can get milk from yaks.


This is a bear. It is big and black. It can climb trees.


This is a barking deer. It barks like a dog. It is reddish brown and has a short tail.




A fox lives under the ground. It comes out at night to look for small animals to eat. It likes to eat hens.
