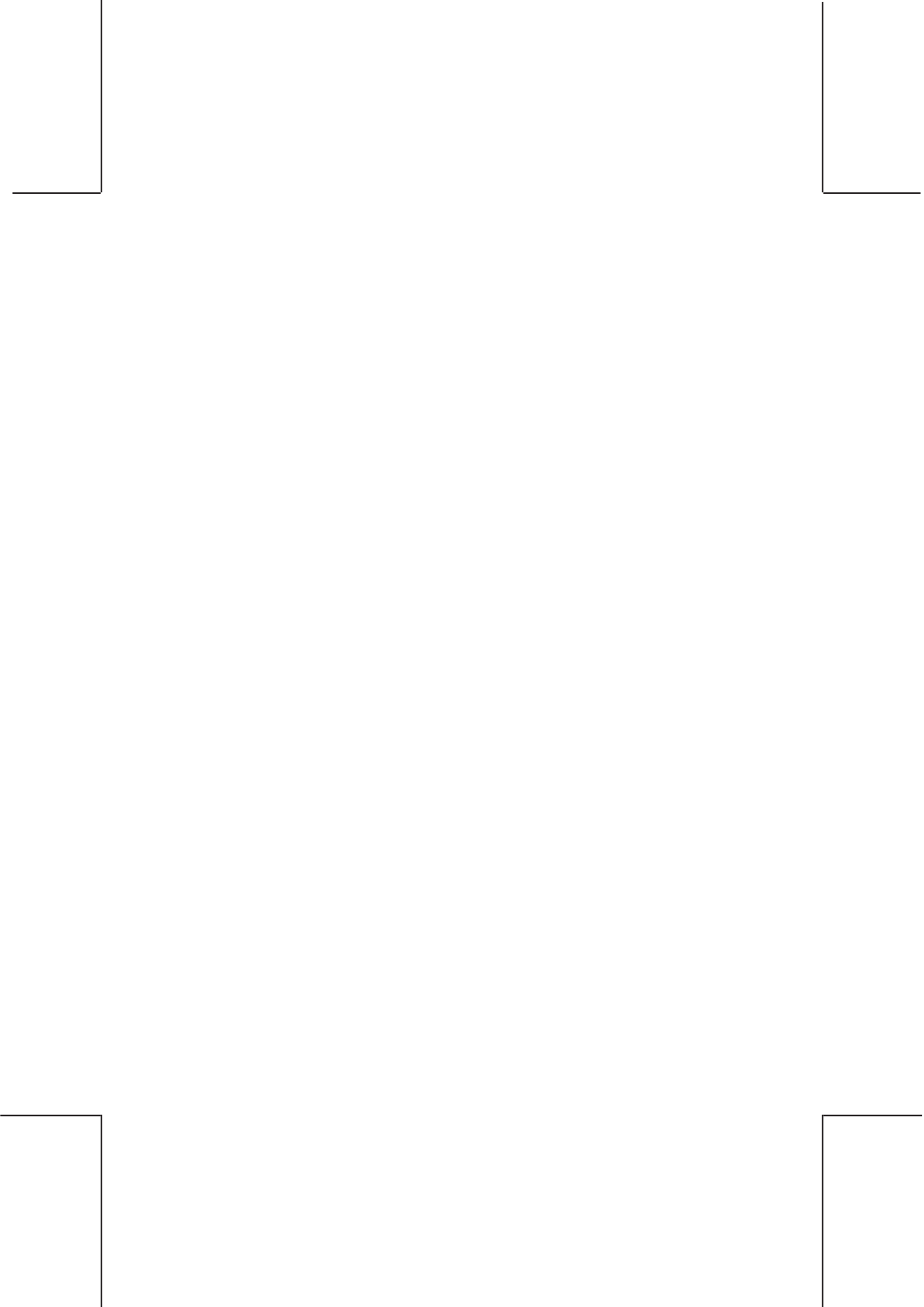

and one yellow chick.



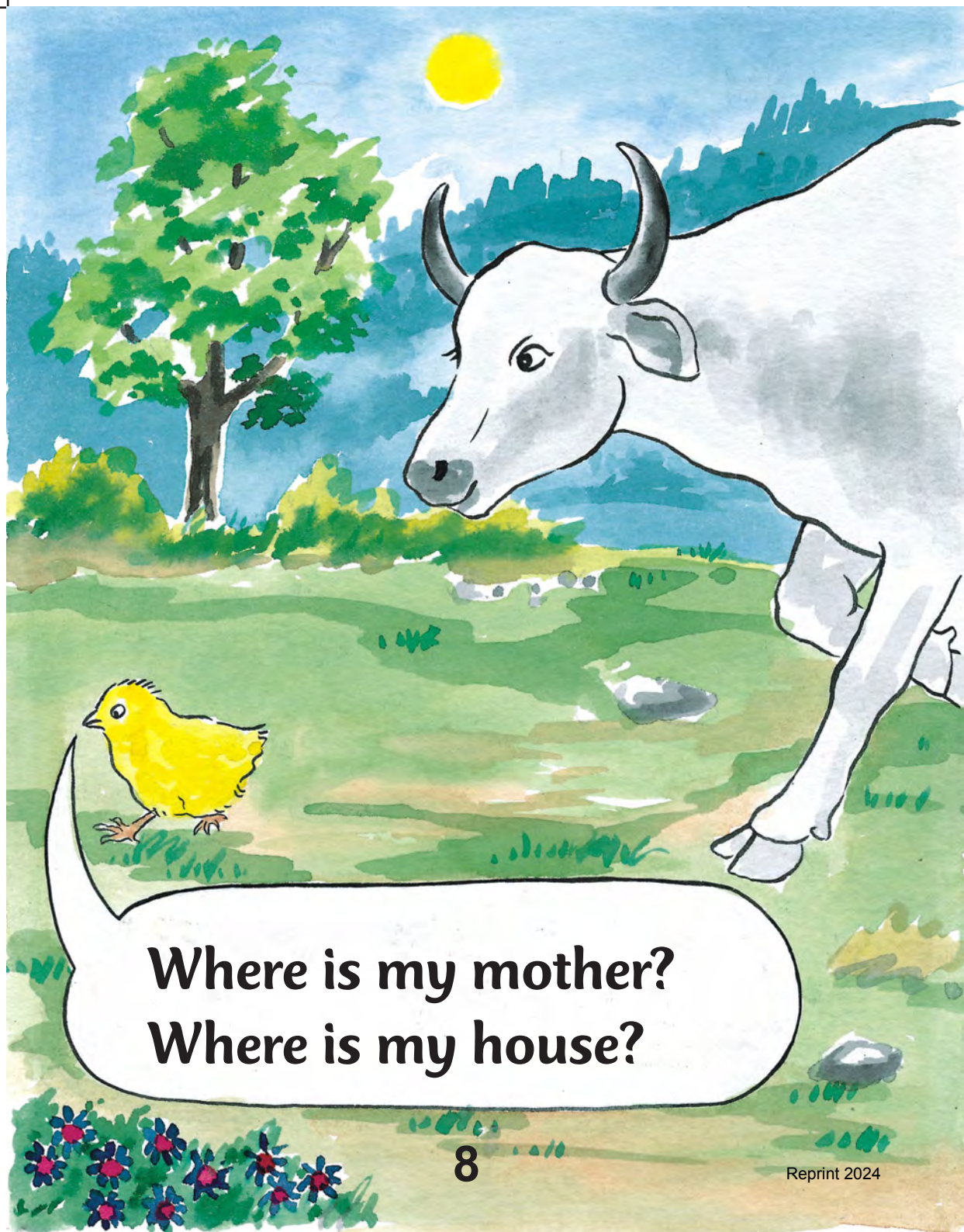


**It is sunny today.

It is a mother pig.**


**Can you count the piglets?**

Is my mother here?**



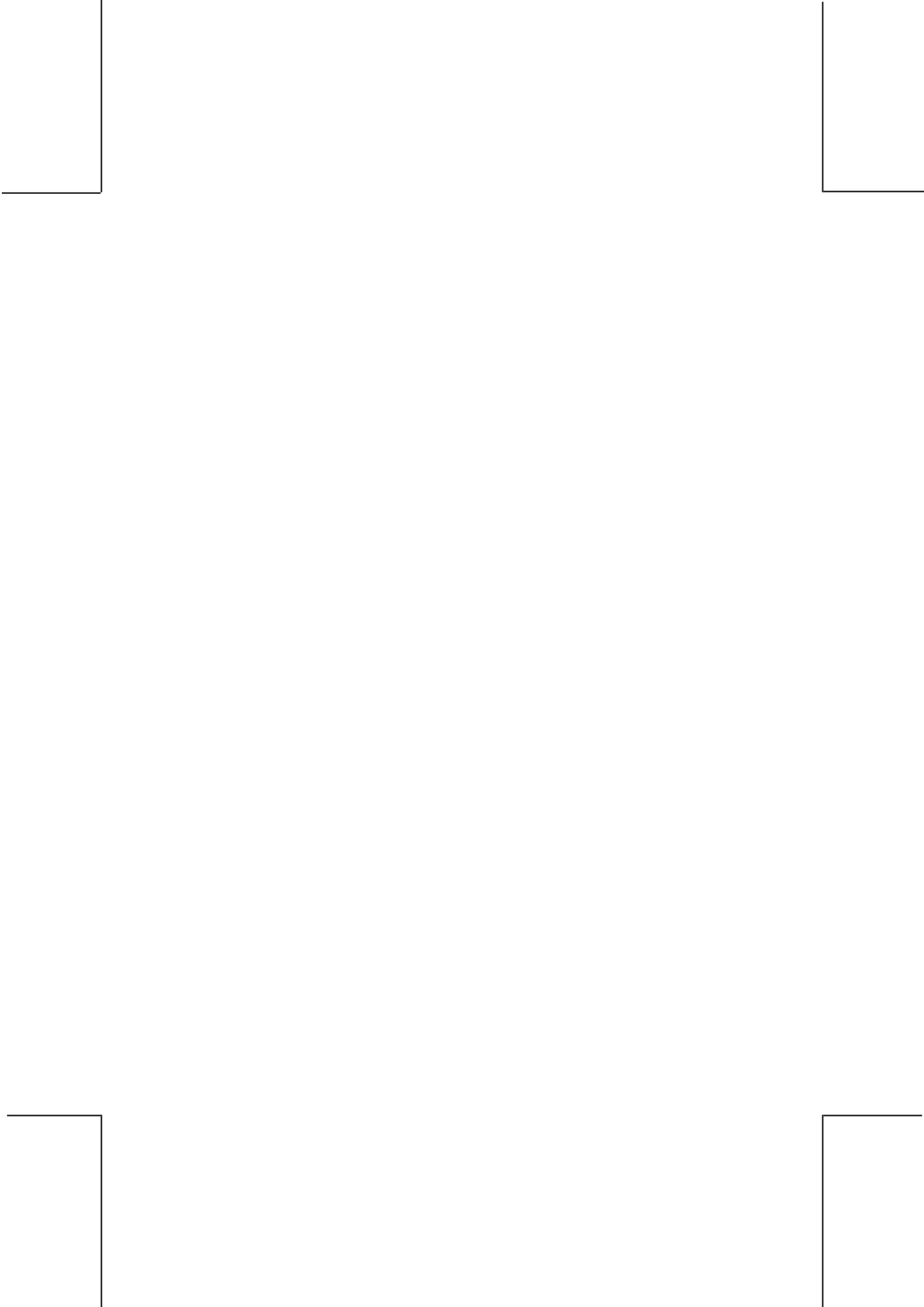


**Here is Dorji's dog.**
