I have many cousins but I meet them only during Christmas.

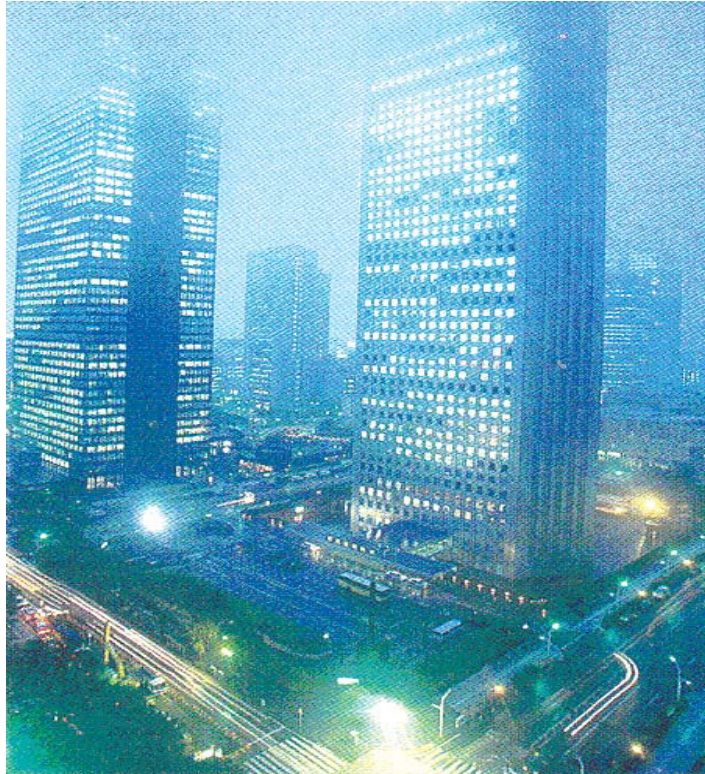
I like apple pie. My mum is a good cook. She prepares tasty pies.
