People read signs every day. Many signs remind us of the rules we must follow to be safe. This sign tells people it is safe to cross the street.



This is called zebra crossing. In some places, people use this sign to cross the road. This sign tells people it is safe to cross the road.



Now the sign tells people it is not safe to cross the street.



This sign tells people not to throw paper, food, or things like plastic bottles on the ground.



People sometimes go out to eat and drink. What will happen if these people throw away plastic containers after they finish eating? Remember, it is a good rule not to leave behind the trash.





This sign could save your life. There could be many reasons why it is not safe to swim here. Even if you don't know why, it is important to obey the sign.



This sign warns that a school is ahead. Drivers will have to slow down.



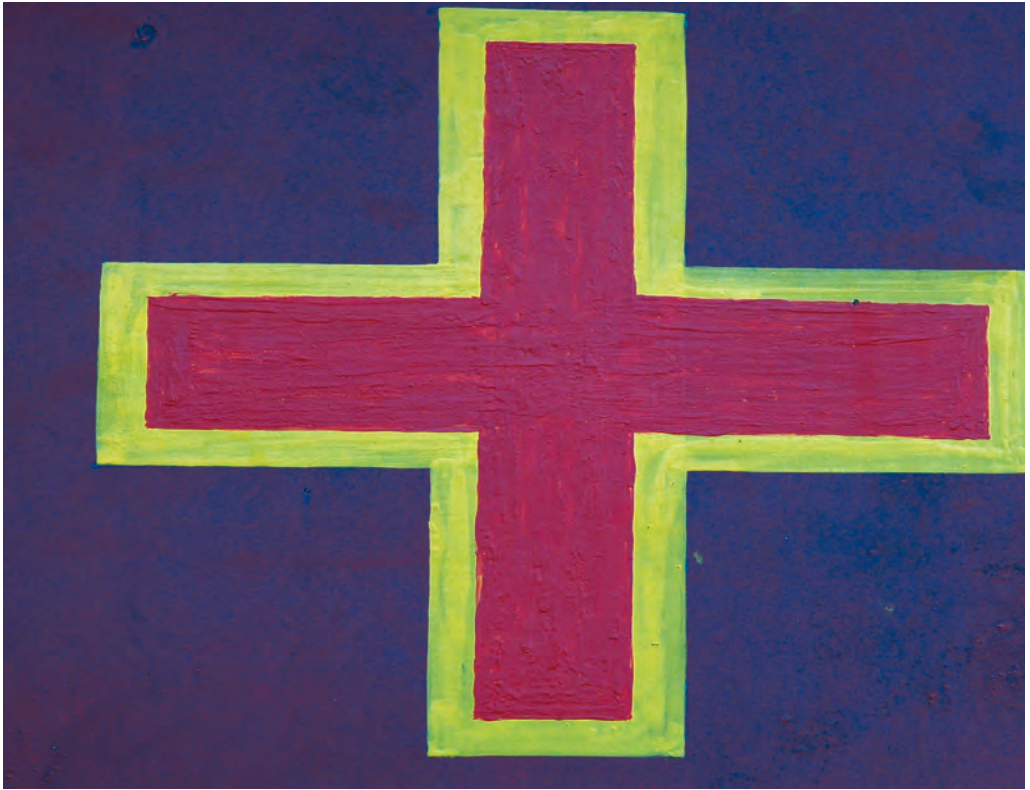
This sign warns drivers that there is a children's playground ahead. Drivers will have to slow down.



This sign warns that a school bus stop is ahead. Drivers will have to slow down.



This sign warns that a fire station is near. Fire engines use this road.



This sign is for hospitals and BHUs. When you see this sign on the road, it tells you that a hospital or BHU is ahead.



This sign warns drivers not to park their cars here.



Some people may have difficulty if they have to park far away from a building. This sign saves a parking space for them. No one else can park in a space with this sign. Isn't that a nice rule?





This sign warns that the road turns left. Drivers should slow down.



This sign warns that there is a dangerous curve ahead to the right.



This sign warns people not to ride bicycles here.



This sign warns people not to cross the road here.



The arrows on this sign tell drivers that there are two lanes on this road.



DANGER! PAY ATTENTION! Everyone has to stop at a stop sign. Cars stop. Bicycles stop. Motorcycles stop. Trucks stop. It's the rule. Stop, look, and listen! A train could be coming down the tracks. Don't cross the tracks until the train has gone past.



This sign warns drivers to watch out for cattle. An open range means the cattle have no fences to keep them off the road.



People use roads to travel from place to place. Animals have to get from place to place, too. This sign warns drivers that deer cross the road around here.
